This movement represents the industry of Newcastle-Under-Lyme, it's history with the pottery industry, and also includes sonic allusions to the circus to pay homage to the town's connection to showman Philip Astley.

"Teacup Percussion" parts are intended to be played with a teaspoon on pottery cups, the sort of which Stoke-on-Trent and Newcastle-Under-Lyme have a historical connection to. However, should these be unavailable, any good mug will do the trick. Have fun playing around with different mugs and teacups to see which sound you like best, and don't forget to have a good cup of tea and a biscuit afterwards.

Rehearsal Mark 3 can be repeated *Ad. Lib.* if the ensemble includes improvising members, to give everybody a chance to solo. The piece lends itself well to jazz solos and improvisation!

To be played either after and in contrast to *The Banks of Lyme Brooke* as its companion piece, or can stand alone.


